Father was married to Sarah E. Fox in 1848 and came west overland in 1853 and settled in San Francisco there was ten children by this marriage their names, Francisco who died in Michigan 1858. Mary born 1857 she crossed the plains with them then Louis T. Born 1854 in S. T. Adelbert S. Born at LaPorte, Calif 1857, Fred S. at LaPorte 1859 Clarissa at L. P. 1862 Clester S. L. P. 1863 Eva M. L. P. 1864, W. C. L. P. 1861 Kittie M. S. P. 1865. of this family I am the ^{only} ~~one~~¹⁸⁸⁷ living
