unto Allen Green of the Town and County of Chataugua State of New York
All that certain parcel of Land situate in the Town of Napoleon aforesaid
and described as follows. It being the East half of North east quarter of Section
No. Seven in the fourth South of Range No. two East, containing Eighty acres of Land
be the same more or less. With all the appurtenances and all the right, title
interest, claim and demand of the said Grantors in the premises. To have and to
hold the same with the appurtenances unto the said Allen Green his heirs and
Assigns in fee simple forever; And they the said Samuel Dugley and Elizabeth
his Wife for themselves and their heirs do hereby Covenant and agree with the said
Allen Green and his heirs and Assigns that they are seized of a good and
indefeasible Estate of inheritance therein and that they have full right and
power to sell and Convey the same in fee simple absolute. That the said
premises are free and clear of all incumbrances; That the said Allen Green
his heirs and Assigns may forever hereafter have hold possess and enjoy the same
without any suit Molestation or interruption by any person whatever lawfully
claiming any right therein. And that they the said Samuel Dugley and Elizabeth
his Wife and their heirs will warrant and defend the said premises with the
appurtenances unto the said Allen Green and his heirs and Assigns forever
