Also one other tract - bounded as follows - being a part of Marcus Cooks Entry 174 beginning at the North East corner of C. V. S. Proffersons 58 Acre Entry South 20 poles to the North West corner of the Thos. Pickers - S. C. Casner, thence North with the Cooks C. B. line 218 poles to a chestnut, thence West 74 poles to a stake, thence S. C. corner, thence South 198 poles to the beginning containing 11 1/4 Acs being a part of the said 174 acre Entry in the name of the said Marcus Cook. Seddon for a balance of Twenty Dollars & interest - on said note due the 1<sup>st</sup> of October 1866, & one note on John Law William Laws & Francis Laws for four hundred & due the 1<sup>st</sup> of December next with two credits amounting to one hundred & twenty one Dollars, with the Land bond for said notes, the balance in Cash and I asson Halkers warrant - the title to said Land to be good against all other Claims or Claimants of all persons whomsoever, in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, this 7<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1868
