I King prater & know all men by these presents that  
Deed of 140 acres of I Bruce prater Sr of the County of Wayne  
Conveyed by I and State of Tennessee have this day for the  
Bruce prater of Natural Love and affection which I have and bear  
for my son King prater of the County and State aforesaid and in  
consideration of his kindness and attention to me and my wife  
Martha Given granted bargained and sold and by these presents  
do give grant bargain and sell unto my said son King prater  
and his heirs for ever the remainder interest in and to all the real  
Estate which I now own after my death and the death of my  
said wife Martha which ~~real~~ said real estate is situate in said  
County of Wayne on Beech Creek in Range 10 and section 2 and  
which is bounded as follows To wit one tract containing 10 acres  
beginning on an Ironwood 40 poles west of the North west corner of  
Entry No 1221 running thence South 56 2/3 poles to a Hickory thence west  
28 1/3 poles to a Lombard thence North 56 2/3 poles to a Sugar tree  
thence East 28 1/3 poles to the beginning one other tract containing 34  
acres beginning at a Lombard the South East corner of Entry No  
940 thence South crossing said Creek at 12 poles in all 90 poles  
to a black gum thence west 27 1/10 poles to a black oak thence South  
20 poles to a white oak thence west 72 poles to a Stake thence North  
69 poles to a Sassafras thence East 30 poles to a dogwood thence  
North 18 poles to a Hickory thence East crossing said Creek at  
55 poles in all 145 poles & 7/10 to the beginning also one other tract  
containing 96 acres beginning 25 poles North from the S. W.  
corner of James Robinsons 20 acre Entry No 1424 thence West 32  
poles to the South west corner of Hallaway praters 10 acre Entry  
thence North 58 poles to a Stake in the South boundary of the  
McClinn & Vassants 80 acre Entry thence west with the same 58  
poles to a stake in E Rays E. B. line thence South 83 poles to a white  
oak thence west twelve poles to a black oak & pointers thence South  
one hundred poles to a Hickory thence East 100 poles to a Stake thence  
North 125 poles to the beginning containing together 140 acres be  
the same more or less with the hereditaments and appurtenances  
there to belonging to you and to hold the said remainder in and  
to the above described tracts of land unto the said King prater  
his heirs and assigns forever which said interest is the remainder  
in said lands after the death of myself and my said wife Martha  
and which is not to pass by this deed until the death of both  
me and my said wife I hereby bind myself my heirs and  
representatives that I will warrant and forever defend the said  
remainder in and to said lands against the lawful claims of all  
and every person or persons what ever unto the said King  
prater his heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof
