This Indenture made this third day of March in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred between Daniel Johnston
of the County of Rutherford and State of North Carolina of the
one part and Frederick Burnet of the County and State aforesaid
of the other part witnesseth, that the said Daniel Johnston
for and in consideration of the sum of thirty seven pounds
ten shillings in hand paid by the said Frederick Burnet

stand before the Sealing and delivering of this instrument of receipt and payment whereof I hereby acknowledge, the 1st day of December 1775, that I, Daniel Johnston for himself and his heirs doth bargain sell all in Ruff and confirm unto the sd. Frederick Burnet his heirs &c, and I assigne forwar a certain piece of land in the County of Rutherford Situate and lying as by the plat with Appurtenance it being apart of the old two hundred acre Survey that J. D. Johnston bought of Peter M. Jones, 60 acres branch off Second broad river Beginning on the west bank of the branch on a white oak running thence South twenty eight west to a black oak on Johnston's line thence with his line North sixty two west Ninety six poles to his and Burnet's pine corner thence with his other line or the twenty eight last forty poles to Jones black oak corner thence with his line South eighty east forty eight poles to his post oak corner in the old field thence with his other dividing line north sixty seven east to the west bank of the branch to a post iron and thence down the branch as the water runs to the Beginning containing fifty acres be the same more or less, with allways mead waters and long the Appurtenances therunto belonging or appertaining to have and to hold to the sd. Frederick Burnet his heirs &c, or assigns forwar and the sd. Daniel Johnston for himself his heirs &c, and Assigne that he the sd. Daniel Johnston his heirs &c, and Assigne shall and will warrant and forwar defend the sd. piece or parcels of land with all and every of its members and Appurtenances free from all lawfull claims of any other person or persons what so ever unto the sd. Frederick Burnet his heirs &c, or assigns forwar; On witness whereof the sd. Daniel Johnston hath caused to set his hand and seal the day and year first above written.
